Know Ye, That the GILBERT & BENNETT MANUFACTURING COMPANY, a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Connecticut, and located in the Town of Redding, in the County of Fairfield, in said State, acting herein by John H. Mulliken, its Chairman, duly authorized,

for the consideration of One dollar and other valuable considerations

does remise, release, and forever QUIT-CLAIM unto the said TOWN OF WILTON, its

it the said releasor have or ought to have in or to ALL that certain tract or parcel of land, with the school building and other improvements thereon, situated in Georgetown, in the Town of Wilton, County of Fairfield and State of Connecticut, being in quantity three (3) acres, more or less, and bounded:

NORTHERLY: by highway, Connecticut State Route #107, so-called;

EASTERLY: by highway, New Street, so-called;

SOUTHERLY: by land now or formerly of Gustav Johnson and Eva Johnson;

WESTERLY: by land now or formerly of District No. 10 of the Town of Wilton

Being the same premises conveyed by Releasor to District No. 10 of the Town of Wilton by deed dated September 1, 1916 and recorded in Volume 30 at Page 396 of the Wilton Land Records.
